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# Divine Teaching Speech from Third Oshienushi-Sama

The preparation for the global expansion is in progress. Establish firm attitudes for our Divine Service to bring a new era in the growth period.

### **Activities in December and January**

At the beginning of the New Year, let me make a new year's greetings. A very happy new year to all of you! I wish the best to you all for a brilliant year.

In December, we held the entrance examinations for the applicants of the 55th class of Yoko College and



the 10th class of Yoko High School after the Ohoharahi Ceremony. From December 21st, we dispatched the cultural exchange tour to Yangzhou in China for the junior high school students (junior ambassadors). In addition to holding 2nd Oshienushi-sama's annual ascension ceremony, we held the traditional rice-cake making event, and the New-Year ceremony.

Regarding the upcoming activities in January, the New Year's greeting party will be held after today's Monthly Commencement Ceremony. Tomorrow, we will celebrate the coming-of-age ceremony for the students in Yoko College and graduates of Yoko High School who turned 20 years old. I will also attend the New Year's festivities around the country.

### Great progress in expansion activities in USA

Hereafter, we will intensify our efforts in the Global Expansion activities. I strongly believe that we should have a decent and firm base of expansion in the USA; therefore, I have desired to establish centers in the east, west, south and northern regions in the USA. New York Dojo covers the East, Los Angeles Dojo is for the West, Chicago Dojo is the North, and Houston Dojo is in the South. Kamikumites are growing in each region. This time, we purchased the property in Chicago and it should be completed around the end of January.



We have already purchased the property in the state of Hawaii. Around the second half of the 19th century, many Japanese immigrated into Hawaii. As a result, Japanese descendants composed of 40% of Hawaii's population in 1940. Japanese immigrants back then brought their Shinto customs and traditions into Hawaii. Consequently, Hawaii has many Shinto shrines.

Our organization is deeply rooted in ancient Shinto; therefore, I believe our teachings should be accepted by many people in Hawaii and our activities in Hawaii will spread rapidly and widely. With this anticipation, we purchased the property in Hawaii. There are several strict regulations in order for us to even display the signboard of "Divine Light" in Hawaii. The process to obtain permission to do so will take few months. Currently, two Doshis are stationed in Hawaii, preparing to officially open the Hawaii Dojo. This month, I will travel to Hawaii to negotiate with the Honolulu city and Hawaii state officials.

In Chicago, as soon as the building is completed, they can start their own activities. In this way, we have our proper Divine Light centers in Chicago, Los Angeles, and Houston. In Santa Ana, California, we have a brilliant USA Su-za already. We do not yet have a suitable establishment in New York. I am hoping to make some movements in New York in order to establish firm bases in at least all four corners of USA.

### **English Speakers are in High Demand**

As the thanksgiving reporter shared her experience today, we are now in the era when the people speaking English are in high demand. In Hawaii, there are many Japanese; however, English is the main language in the main land of USA. In order to spread our activities in USA, we will need more Japanese who can convey the teachings in English.

Now we have many Taiwanese Doshis. I am confident that they will be in the front to lead the expansion activities in China.

At the end of last year, we organized the tour to take junior high school students (the junior ambassadors) to Yangzhou, China. This time, the Chinese high school students who are studying



Japanese at Sakura Japanese School in Yangzhou, and Japanese junior high school students enjoyed communicating together. Observing how they connected mutually, I found young generations who can speak Japanese and English are rapidly growing in China.

The population of the Anglosphere is about 1.4 billion. This time, I met Chinese government officials and they can speak fluent English. Japanese is not a common language around the world and not so many study Japanese as a foreign language, compared to English. According to the report, the people who can speak English covers the 20 % of the world's population. In China, the population is around 1.4 billion. Among them, many people are studying English; therefore, I guess the population who can





speak English will increase more and more.

In Los Angeles Dojo, people originally from China visit the center to receive Divine Light and they eventually become Kamikumites. To guide these people, English is essential. As such, the young Kamikumites are showing their wonderful power to overcome the language barrier. In this sense, the expansion activities in SMBK will surely progress with the contribution of young generations who can become a bridge of different languages.

Tokyo will attract people around the world. Especially this year, many people will gather in Tokyo due to the Olympics. As such, the people who can speak English will play their great roles.

# Miracle that occurred thanks to sincere practices and the prayers from everyone

Ms. Kouchi, the Thanksgiving reporter, had gone through an extremely severe life or death experience that occurs in one out of 100,000 people. Because of it, cerebral

hemorrhage could



have occurred at any time. A major cleansing happened when she finally got a job and became financially independent after finishing college. I believe that it was certainly a severe cleansing.

I am not a brain surgeon; however, it is widely believed that brain cells die if inundated with blood from a ruptured blood vessel. Accordingly, dead brain cells cannot be revived. However, just by removing abnormal vessels, she was able to recover well enough to go back to work.

Furthermore, she performed as one of the prayer leaders for the divine song at the 57th Grand Anniversary Festival and did her divine service by using English at the 60th Anniversary Festival.



Currently, she is a leader of the youth group of her center. The fact that she had come this far and recovered this well was nothing but proof of the power of sincere prayers and divine light that was given by Kamikumites of her center. With their strong prayers and altruistic actions, in addition to her own dedication to Su-God, He allowed her to overcome this tough cleansing.

Since I once pursued medicine and had some knowledge, I knew that her condition was considered fatal. On the contrary to medical common sense, she overcame it. It was nothing but God who made it happen. This was an obvious miracle that God intended to show to the people who surrounded her, but was also a miracle that God's had arranged to

respond to her sincerity and seriousness toward divine services.

### The souls whom God intends to make a use of.

I am also the person who experienced the edge of death. We have the teachings saying, "Misogi (Cleansing phenomena to scrape off the spiritual impurities) is Misogi. Salvation is salvation." The person who overcame the severe experience either undergoing tough Misogi or receiving a wonderful miracle will be certainly used by God.

I took over the position of President of my own company at the age of 26 years old. Being in the position of the president, I gradually gained the feeling of being wealthy and immortal. As such, hanging out at bars and drinking became my everyday routine. Consequently, I was hospitalized due to a serious liver illness.

This liver illness compromised by digestion system. I nearly lost 20 kg and my lowest weight marked 37kg. I was in the very bottom of the life having no hope to survive. I spent one whole year in the hospital. I would sit there and stare at the trees outside my hospital room window. I observed the yearly cycle of tree lives; new leaves coming out, flourishing, and falling in the autumn. Looking at these changes of the nature trees, I could not help to question myself saying, "Am I now fated to die?" As such, I experienced the depth of the despair. Luckily enough, I was able to regain the health somehow. After overcoming this Misogi-Harahi, I was told, "you can show your great power in this organization." As such, the priority of my life became this Organization.

Since I was young, doing divine service was part of my life. I grew up seeing First and Second

Oshienushi-Samas and they directly shared me various teachings. I began to think that my mission is to carry out what First and Second Oshienushi-Samas intended to achieve. Listening to today's thanksgiving report, she also overcame the tough Misogi-Harahi. This miraculous arrangement must be given to her as she is the soul whom God intends to use for His Plan. I hope she can also grasp God's Will out of her tough experience.

All Kamikumites in her Dojo, as the Mahikari Family, wholeheartedly prayed for her recovery. They dedicated themselves to give Divine Light to her seriously. These acts of selfless love helped her to grow as the soul who will be the motive power for the Dojo, which is located in the middle of Tokyo.

The youth members will lead the Worldwide Expansion. In April, the freshmen who enter universities located in Tokyo will gather to belong to the centers in Tokyo. I expect her to help these people in their settlement in the new environments as the MYA (Mahikari Youth Association) leader. In this way, she can cultivate her Sonen (innermost mind) to be more grateful for her Misogi-Harahi.

Her story reminded me of the period when I had my own physical cleansing.

That was one of the significant arrangements for me that I needed to experience. I assume that this miracle for her to survive AVM (Arteriovenous Malformation) also astonished her doctor.

God is the entity Who can make these incredible miracles. If one is seeking God with his/her heart seriously to live by implementing God's will, God will accept their heartfelt dedications. As the result of that, God gives miracles to the person. I wish Miss. Kouchi to fulfill her mission as the leader of MYA members in her Dojo.

# <u>2020 is the year of Koushi (庚子) in the sexagenarian cycle</u>

What kind of year will 2020 be? According to sexagenarian cycle, the Chinese 60-year calendar cycle, this year is named as Koushi (庚子), the combination of metal and rat). This sexagenarian is the study based on the statistics from 5000 years of Chinese history.

The Chinese Sexagenarian cycle is the combination of ten heavenly stems and twelve earthly branches. The ten heavenly stems are based on the combination of Chinese philosophy of Wuxing and the philosophy of Yin and yang. This is the idea that whole universe is created with the five earthly elements of wood, fire, earth, metal, and water. The philosophy of yin and yang is that everything in the universe has two different aspects such as front and back or positive and negative. According to ten heavenly stems, this year is metal, Kou(美).

Talking about another aspect of twelve earthly branches, Chinese Zodiac, twelve animals were assigned to respectively to each twelve-year cycle. This year is named as rat  $(\neq)$ . This animal, a rat or mouth, has the meaning that something already grown will flourish.

Rats give birth with lots of babies. This is the reason why rat has the symbol of the nourishment. In the sense of human, it means that a baby in the mother's womb will grow or a child will grow.

In ancient China, there were Sima (司馬) officers who were in charge to record what happened each year. About 2200 years ago, Sima Qian who served Emperor Wu of Han during the Han Dynasty created the historiography called Records of the Grand Historian. This covered the history from the very

beginning of China. This is the great source as the statistical reference to analyze the yearly tendency. This Koushi (庚子) year is coming every sixty years and this indicates an upcoming departure. Or we can say something will grow greatly after a big transition.

# 2020 is the year to move on the next phase after a brand-new creation.

The origin of Kanji (Chinese character) comes from Hieroglyph. The letter of Kou (庚) has the meaning of "Update" or "Renewal." In another words, this is to invent something new in order to make further progress.

The letter of "子" is to bring a something new. For instance, "子" indicates that a woman is getting pregnant or a new sprout is germinating from a seed.

From the point of Hieroglyph, letter of "子" expressed the shape that a baby was just born. The newborn babies normally have bigger heads in comparison to their tiny arms and legs. The upper part of "子" expresses the head of the babies and the lower part is their tiny bodies.

In the combination of the letters of "庚" and "子", the year of "庚子" means moving forward after something is born. How we move on next depends on the plan-making procedure from the consideration from various approaches.

# Put into practice what we have planned following the proper order

However, according to the philosophy of yin and yang, both letter of  $\exists$  and  $\not\equiv$  have the positive essences. The combination of these two letters is

actually an unbalanced pair. This implies that the burden essence might increase. The positive side (the visible side) can make a big progress; however, the negative side (the invisible side) can be a big burden. This is the one of the features of the year of Koushi(庚子).

The meaning of Kou is to renew something; therefore, it is important for us to make plans with proper sequences to go forward. As the positive energy is filled in this year, putting something together in the right direction can bring a successful journey to materialize something.

On the other hand, the inpatient actions and skipping necessary process might bring failures during this year. In short, to be a successful person this year, it is important to follow the plans sequentially. This will definitely apply to our Divine Service during the year of Koushi (庚子).

Another important point is to keep your own judgmental point. There are lots of exaggerated news in the media and it is easy for us to be distracted by mass communication. We should establish our own firm viewpoint to judge something, not being influenced by what these media say.

Having more youth members who graduate from Yoko Academy will be the motive power for our expansion activity.

This year marks the 10th year anniversary since the establishment of Yoko High School. Some of the participants in the junior ambassadors' tour in China last month shared their intention to come to Yoko High School; therefore, I am sure that plenty of junior high school students will enroll. I would still like to for ask

your cooperation to encourage youth members at your centers to attend the Yoko College and Yoko High School.

Our achievements last year, the building of the several dojos have been completed in Japan. Regional Su-zas in Taiwan and Mexico have begun their constructions. The new Divine Light Centers in





Hawaii and Chicago are expected to open soon. We will start the new project to find a proper place as the Divine Light Center in New York. As such, establishing Su-za both inside and outside of Japan made wonderful progress.

As such, the projects of constructions of the Su-zas are showing good process. I ask for your contribution to achieve our goals of expansion activities, constructions of the Su-za, and nurturing youth members this year again.

We will need more Doshis in order to bring our activities especially abroad after the 60th Grand Anniversary Festival. The best process is to increase Doshi, which is the motive power to blast the expansion. I hope more youngsters will come to enter Yoko High School and Yoko College.

As I close, I want to remind you that in February we will hold the Risshun Festival. I ask you to invite more Kamikumites to the Risshun Festival to hold a successful ceremony.

Again, thank you very much everyone for your participation in today's ceremony despite the cold winter weather.

Mioya Moto Su Mahikari Ohomikami-sama, Oshienushisama, I am pleased to share my thanksgiving report on the splendid day of the Monthly Commencement Ceremony for January 2020.

My mother learned of the Divine Light Center 27 years ago, after discovering her unexpected pregnancy with me.

My mother felt sick after her trip to Hawaii with her co-workers. She visited a clinic and was told of her pregnancy with me and was given the diagnosis that her fetus's heartbeat was weakening, which might lead to a miscarriage.

Before that, my mother, who hadn't noticed the pregnancy, had flown to Hawaii and enjoyed many things which most pregnant women avoid.

After finding out about her pregnancy, my mother then

asked for advice from her sister who lived in Yamaguchi and she was invited to visit the Divine Light Center.

Although my aunt was not a Divine Light Practitioner at that time, she introduced the Denenchofu Divine Light Center to my mother, as she had felt a change after receiving Divine Light.

Practitioners of the
Denenchofu Center started
visiting my mother to offer
Divine Light. One week later, my
mother visited the clinic for a
check-up. The doctor informed
my mother that my heartbeat
had perfectly improved. My
mother then took the Basic
Seminar, and thereafter I was
fortunately born into this world.

My mother, who had felt a miracle during her pregnancy, visited the Center with me almost every day. Also, my mother invited some of her friends to the Basic Seminar. At the age of 10, I became a Divine Light Practitioner.



Meanwhile, my father never believed in the invisible world; however, he didn't strongly oppose my mother whenever we visited at the Center and attended the Monthly Commencement Ceremony.

My father worked as planner and director of international exposition for an auto show. He independently worked under the theme of peace, harmony and coexistence.

In my adolescent years, my father's work had been decreasing and the atmosphere in my family became heavy due to financial issues. During that time, I received many mental challenges from looking into the expression of my parents.

My one and only salvation at that time was that my way of thinking was based on the Divine Teachings, even though I couldn't grasp the whole meaning of the Divine Teachings on the occasion of the Ceremony.

I was thinking of finding a job and leaving home after graduating from high school. However, I enrolled at the Aoyama University as my mother suggested and with tuition aid from my aunt.

The department head said that the school aimed at cultivating people who can promote cultural power. After entering the university, I learned many things through various activities to grasp what culture is, such as English classes given by native speakers, an economics class, art and architecture, cultural communication events and so on.

Each time, I was impressed with



innovative ideas from the beautiful people I met. I felt the value of a person who has unique ideas beyond generalization, and their attitude seemed to resemble that of my father.

However, my parents got divorced in the middle of my university years. I partly blamed my father who couldn't maintain his family. However, I respected him as a producer.

Thanks to the opportunities to learn so many things at the university, I felt my viewpoint and way of understanding things had become diversified and multilateral.

Fruitful time in the university flew so fast and I never became interested in the economic activity of a company. One day, a friend of mine invited me to attend an introductory meeting of enterprises. There, I coincidentally received a promise of employment to teach an English conversation class.

When I was a child, a Center Chief who was proficient in English offered English conversation classes for kids. Through this experience, I had become a good speaker of English. I believed that work related to the use of the English



language meant a stable future, so I decided to enter the company and graduated from university.

After applying to the company, I was assigned to the department that was one of the busiest in the company; moreover, my workplace gave me many responsibilities despite my being a newcomer.

Challenges occurred from the new system of management set by the company. Each process absorbed a tremendous amount of time, important data was completely deleted, and I always worked until midnight in order to carry out my routine and miscellaneous jobs.

Although my business performance was positive, I always thought I would quit my job due to severe circumstances.

On August 31st, 2015, I fainted from a severe headache and vomiting just as I woke up for work.

My mother suspected that I


had fainted from anemia and put me to bed. However, she immediately called an ambulance due to my slurred speech. After I was taken to the hospital, the doctor said to my mother: "Your daughter is in critical condition, there is no other way than to begin surgery in order to avoid a severe situation". After learning about my serious condition, in a panic, she immediately called my father and a senior Practitioner.


After my mother completed the required process to give permission for my surgery, she stepped into the waiting room and found many Divine Practitioners gathered there to support her.

One after another, many Practitioners visited the hospital to offer Divine Light towards the operating room with their prayer. Fortunately, my operation that took twice longer than the expected time was successful and I could remain in this world.

The doctor diagnosed me with a stroke caused by the brain artery birth deformity.

In my case, the deformity that one out of hundreds of thousands had, an extra blood vessel was located in the middle of my brain. An abnormal





hemorrhage had occurred in my brain. My brain was filled with blood and the very narrow blood vessel made surgery difficult.

One week after my surgery, I was moved from the ICU (Intensive Care Unit) to a general ward. However, I had to face the fact that I had lost half of both my eyesight and memories of my graduation at the university after recovering consciousness. Since my IQ (Intelligence Quotient) and memories had declined, I couldn't remember the location of my ward.

I received rehabilitation to recover from the aftereffects of the stroke every day. In the beginning, I was struggling to memorize and answer even easy things, such as my home address, date, place and name of the hospital. Other than my name and day of birth, I would completely forget whatever I had heard the previous day.

In order to encourage me in giving Divine Light, Divine Light Practitioners visited me every single day. Thanks to their warm support, I spent cheerful days in the hospital as other patients envied my situation.

My IQ and memories recovered through the daily rehabilitation and receiving abundant Divine Light, I, who struggled to memorize beginning level Chinese characters, could read an English article and give a summary of it. Two and half months later, I was able to leave the hospital.

Moreover, my IQ improved to 129 after one year of rehabilitation even though the average IQ in Tokyo University was about 120. I felt the supernatural power of God's blessings beyond the knowledge of human beings. Thank you very much.

After leaving the hospital, I returned to work and visited the Divine Light Center every day. Whenever I offered Divine Light to others, I felt happy and appreciated how precious it is to

practice the Art giving Divine Light since the best I could do was to receive Divine Light in the hospital.

Through severe challenges, I came around to view that God perfectly prepared everything for human beings in order to be able to conduct their lives in this Physical World. Everything around me was filled with happiness. My mother encouraged me by saying: "The best is yet to come!" I also believed that continuous calm days would come to me in the future.

However, only three months



after leaving the hospital, a doctor found another abnormal blood vessel had formed in my brain during my periodic medical checkup. If another new vessel extended onto the area, the possibility for more recurrences of bleeding became higher. On the other hand, in some cases it might go fine, so the doctor let my mother and I to make the final

say on if I would undergo another surgery or not.

Making a decision to have another surgery was very tough for non- professional people like my mother and I. We then visited and asked the advice of Mr.

Nakaguchi who is a doctor as well as a permanent member of this Organization. He readily recommended me to have the surgery and introduced me to a famous doctor who worked as a chairman for a newly discovered form of radiation therapy. Thus, I had the most advanced radiation therapy in May of 2016.

My father attended the Basic Seminar for me just before my surgery, and I felt my father's deep affection.

After having the radiation



therapy, I was given the Divine Service of Prayer Leader of the Divine Song at the 57th Grand Anniversary Festival.

With the sincere and kind support from an assistant Doshi,



I, who had an impaired memory, could function, could apply myself to practice the movements of a Prayer Leader and chant Prayers. On the day of the Ceremony, I was allowed to accomplish my Divine Service. Thank you indeed.

I then visited the doctor for another medical checkup. The abnormal new vessel had disappeared. I was very surprised that the symptom took a turn for the better after only a half year even though everyone expected that it would take several years.

Another half year later, they had a suspicion that a new abnormal vessel may unfortunately be discovered during the checkup.

The Doctor expected that another new vessel might possibly be growing in a part of the deformity in my brain where it seemed to be improved.

I became depressed with the repetitious situation in which new irregular vessels would turn up

and then disappear.

The difference between the first time of this challenge and that time was my IQ had recovered enough, so fears and anxiety flashed through my mind for one month before taking a detailed examination. Nevertheless, I felt secure about my future, thanks to the great support and prayers with genuine concern from our Center Chief, Doshis and Practitioners.

I then prepared myself for everything as being God's arrangement.

According to the detailed medical checkup, the suspicion of having a new abnormal vessel had been removed, and I realized God's blessings from the result.

Every morning, my mother says "Good morning, happy to see you today!" and hugs me after I reply "Good morning" to her. I am sure that now is the best part of my entire life. I will rely on the path that God prepares for me without any doubt.



I have been appointed the chief of MYA at my Center. I will encourage many young Practitioners to serve God together, aiming that each one of us can actively dedicate ourselves to do Divine Service for the sake of God.



Moreover, I would like to use my English skills which I started learning at the Center for my future Divine Services.

I can surprisingly understand

English again even though I struggled with the beginner's Chinese letters after I fell sick. At the 60th Grand Anniversary Festival, I served as staff to accommodate many attendees from other countries using English skills.

I acquired a license to be an English teacher in an elementary school in order to fully use the abilities that God bestowed in me.Certainly, I love Japanese, but Japanese is basically used only in Japan. If a person can speak English as a second language, a person will be blessed with opportunities to make conversation with twenty percent of people in the world. I would like to open English conversation classes for children in the Center in order to offer opportunities aiming at becoming the International People that Oshienushi-sama really wishes us to be.

Thanks to the tremendous amount of God's blessings and kind support from many people from before I was born to today,

I can now stand here. I will make efforts to become a person who is required by God to fulfill my mission in this Physical World as long as I live.
